

Mama Chickpea

FEATHERS:

Place hat stretched over a hat stand or your largest kitchen canister. You want a shape that's approximately head-sized. (This is because the boa doesn't stretch like the hat.)

Thread the large needle with some yarn scraps, about 3 feet long. This is to sew-on your boa.

Start by attaching the end of the boa at one point of the brim of the hat. Weave the needle through a loop in the knit hat, and tie around the boa. Knot and snip the stray ends. Sew it on about an inch above the cast on row.

Now to continue the boa around the brim of the hat. Do as with the first attachment, sewing every 4 inches or so.

After you have gone around the brim, start to swirl up the hat, spacing the boa about 2-3 inches from the last boa piece. Keep attaching. Only cut the boa at the end, as it sheds like crazy, when it gets a fresh cut!

Attach the last sewn spot at the top of the hat, and snip the remaining boa that is unneeded, off.

Viola! You've been feathered!
